### Moorlands SUDs Project or 'What's happening at the front of school?'

Each year our school pays a considerable amount of money to the water company based on the amount of rainwater which flows from our building and grounds into the mains drains system. Sustainable Urban Drainage Systems (SUDS) are solutions to re-route this water into the ground away from these drains.

Moorlands was chosen from a number of schools as a site to have this work completed free of charge funded by BITC and their partners, one of which is United Utilities. The project includes the installation of a new permeable path and car park surface and the creation of Rain Gardens; populated with plants that will thrive in the environment created by pooling the surface water. Following completion of the works school will save a considerable amount each year on water utility costs.

Our Eco Council has been involved with the design of the Rain Gardens and we are delighted that the project is being officially opened and launched to other local business leaders in the field on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> of April . We will then be used as a show case site.

The project has also gathered local and national interest and both the BBC North West and the Manchester Evening News have picked up the story so keep an eye out on the news next Wednesday you may even spot some little people you know.
