If the answer is yes to either of the above questions then pop 6.30pm on Tuesday 4th December into your diary and come along to the school hall where you will be able to learn more.

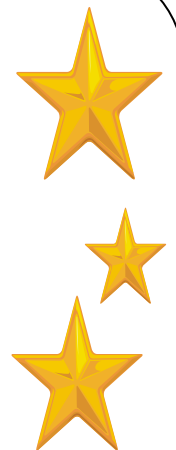
