Enhanced Measures in Trafford Early Years and Education Settings

The most recent review decided that:

- All local enhanced measures below will remain in place
- Household Contacts:
 - Start daily LFD testing as soon as they become aware that a member of their household has tested positive (KS2 and above).
 - Have a PCR test as per national guidance
 - Household contacts do NOT need to stay at home until they receive their PCR test result
 - Continue to LFD test for a period of 10 days even if their PCR is negative
 - Household contacts can now continue to attend school, if household contacts develop Covid symptoms or return a positive LFD test then they need to start to self-isolate and go for a PCR test immediately.
