#### **Covid 19 Guidelines**

Since August 16th the need for bubbles or close contacts to self-isolate has been removed as long as they:

- Are under the age of 18 years and 6 months
- Are double vaccinated
- Are unable to get a vaccination due to advice from their medical consultant for medical reasons
- they have taken part in or are currently part of an approved COVID-19 vaccine trial

The recommendation is however that as a close contact a PCR test (not a Lateral Flow Test) is taken to rule out being asymptomatically positive. With this in mind we may ask you to take your child for a test if we identify them as being a close contact.
