School Streets

During the consultation for the building of the extended school, concerns were raised by parents and local residents around increased traffic and parking outside of school, particularly on Temple Road.

As a school we liaised with One Trafford and the decision was made to speak to parents and local residents about the feasibility of introducing a School Street on Temple road between the junctions with Dane Road and Broad Road- please see attached map for clarity.

It is proposed to a hold a series of one day trials on Wednesday 6th December 2023 and Tuesday 12th December 2023; the attached letter on class dojo gives more details about what this entails and how you can get involved.

We hope that by looking at a way to reduce traffic at peak times we can provide a safe route to school for our children and their families.
