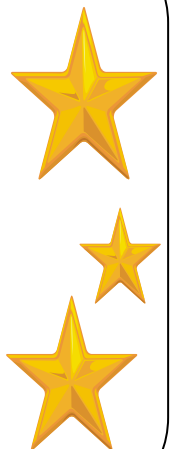
Fay Evans Author Visit
