As we have mentioned previously, we are constantly reviewing our offer and striving to improve the provision we can offer for our home learners. All teachers are offering a regular drop in session each day and are available to give personalised help or feedback to children who need it. If your child is struggling with any aspect of the work, please encourage them to use this facility as often problems can be ironed out much more quickly than over dojo or online chats.

The live registration and early morning session also has a safeguarding function of checking in with each child. Please can you ensure that your child logs in using their correct name and where possible, has their camera turned on and answers questions verbally when asked. A large proportion of the time is being spent reminding children of this.

Next week we will be introducing some live intervention sessions to the timetable for children who would have received this support in school. These sessions will be by invitation, your class teacher will inform you if your child should attend.
