We are delighted to announce that we have been awarded the music mark in recognition of all the fantastic music work and musical achievements of the children and staff at Moorlands.

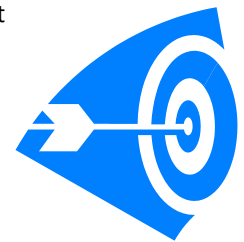
